Six and a half years ago the board of directors of Lutheran Island Camp made the decision to begin looking for additional land to provide a location for expanded programming in creation, leadership, and horseback riding. Very soon after that 275 acres was identified as being for sale. It was located about 3 miles from camp.

Over the next years the board moved forward with additional planning and then turned the responsibilities to purchase and plan the development of the property over to a task force.

We are pleased to be able to report to you that today the Friends of Creation-Science Limited Liability Company purchased the property we call Christ Serve Ranch. The property will now be leased to Lutheran Island Camp for its programs.

The plan is that Lutheran Island Camp will eventually purchase the property from the Limited Liability Company. (The Lutheran Island Camp Foundation already owns 15 of the 20 LLC units). We continue to seek additional gifts and investors.
