Nature Watch: One of our Bald Eagles was on the road the other day snacking on a fish that he had scavenged from the lake shore. He attempted to take off with his prize but was unsuccessful. We spotted a medium sized otter at Lutheran Island Camp. He went loping by one of the buildings with the distinctive otter lope. He headed down to the water and swam off. We've been spotting wood chucks frequently and they are putting on the pounds in preparation for winter. Several of us took a tour of Christ Serve Ranch last week and spotted two nice bucks, a doe, and two fawns from this year. We also saw a flock of 10-12 adult turkeys. Leaves continue to change color and drop. Color change is about two weeks earlier than normal which is likely due to the stress of lack of moisture in the last month. Strangely, the grass continues to stay green despite little in recent rains. Hours of sunshine continue to drop precipitously and will soon drop below 12 hours a day. Animals take note by beginning to add pounds and hair or fur in preparation for winter.

Question and Answer:

Question: Does your group believe that God created the earth in six, twenty-four hour days?

1. Answer: Yes, we do. Our statement concerning that is: **“In six days the LORD made the heavens and the earth, the sea, and all that is in them” (Ex. 20:8).** Regarding Creation, the Fall, and the book of Genesis, we confess:
 - Genesis is to be taken in its natural and literal sense, being fully accurate in all it describes and teaches;
 - the universe and the earth is of recent origin (not millions or billions of years), being supernaturally created in six normal days by God;
 - the various original life-forms (kinds) were made by direct creative acts of God during the first six days and do not evolve into other life-forms, though

there may be “horizontal” changes (variations) within each life-form or “downward” changes (e.g., harmful mutations, extinctions);

- the first human beings did not evolve from an animal ancestry but were created on the sixth day, in the image of God, and set apart and above all other created things;
