Christ Serve Ranch

The Creation-Science Environmental Learning Center will be located on a 275-acre site called Christ Serve



Ranch in beautiful west central Minnesota. The location is at the confluence of the native forests of Minnesota and the

prairies that extend out into the Dakotas. This scenic

acreage includes or provides access to seven different eco-systems (lake, lakeshore, stream, ponds, cultivated forest, native forest, and native prairie). Observation platforms will be provided in unique settings that will allow participants to watch wild life, aquatic life, birds and insects.

Programming will be provided for all ages, but will especially focus on children and teachers. A young scientist program will give gifted youngsters a weeklong experience which will look at each of the six days of creation through experiences, instruction, Bible Study and worship.

Why Now?

With the loss of family farms, today's hectic schedules, a move to theme park vacations, and schools that promote a non-Christian perspective, young people today often do not understand how God uses creation to feed and clothe His people. Their understanding of nature is often clouded by evolutionary doctrine put forth by teachers who are or are forced to be Darwinian apostles. And, often these children do not have an opportunity to "Be still and know that I am God" as God uses His creation to demonstrate His great power and might and His great love.
